Primary Responsibilities

- Implementation of club methodology, effective practice, and game model
- Adhere and reinforce Club and UPSL policies, guidelines, regulations, and safety standards in every setting

- Collaborate with Technical staff on the identification, assessment, and recruitment of prospective players
- Participate and support player ID and recruitment clinics, as well as community and grassroots initiatives and events
- Participate in coach training programs to ensure continuous education
- Other duties as assigned by Supervisor / Management
